Items Discussed:

• Quit open applications on smartphones to make them run faster and conserve battery life

- Rules:
 - 1. Commit to the technology
 - 1. Put all of your events into your phone. Keep it current. Use daily.
 - 2. Create & use a CRM
 - 3. Save notes & memos in phone instead of on paper
 - 4. Prepare a "show listings anywhere" photo presentation (photos of current inventory)
 - 2. Take advantage of features
 - 1. Take the time to set up options for each application
 - 2. Bookmark frequently used websites
 - 3. Practice taking photos and videos
 - 4. Add apps as needed.
 - 5. Create shortcuts to make navigation easier and faster
 - 3. Customize your device to make it uniquely yours
 - 1. Speed dials and application shortcuts
 - 2. Customize screen and each application for optimal navigation
 - 3. Talk hands free Bluetooth
 - 4. Customize your device for a unique look, sound, & response
 - 5. Add accessories to extend battery life
 - 4. Get creative!
 - 1. Use camera & video camera to record and send updated photos & video
 - 2. Share up-to-date information with followers
 - 3. Always remember special dates for past clients
 - 4. Use MMS to do remote showings (pictures to spouse who is not there)
- Monthly mobile maintenance tips
 - Turn off wifi and Bluetooth
 - Turn down screen brightness
 - Delete apps installed but not used (some of them may even be using your data even when not running)
 - Turn off push notifications for apps you don't use (notification center on iPhone/iPad)
- Add contact entry in your phone for ICE phone, blood type, medications, etc.
