

# 2016 Accomplishments: 9/11 Memorial



 Completed the Northside Hospital-Cherokee Amphitheater and hosted Mark Wills in concert in November.



- Total value of new construction permits issued in 2016: approximately \$200 Million for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row.
- 332 new single family permits issued, second most since before the Great Recession

- Added 26 parking spaces at City Center and 18 spaces by the Elm Street Event Green
- Completed Rubes Creek Trail
- Completed overflow parking lot at Old Rope Mill Park.
- Completed renovations of the lobby at City Center.

- Construction was begun on the following projects:

  - Fairfield Inn and Suites
  - Sprouts Farmers Market
